Criteria and eligibility

The Property Law Section (PLS) curates a Hall of Fame and is looking forward to welcoming the next round of inductees.

The Hall of Fame recognises individuals whose contribution has been truly outstanding and who, over their careers, have demonstrated exemplary service to the legal profession and to the practice of property law. They might, for example, be lawyers (practising or retired) or academics. Current full or associate membership of the New Zealand Law Society and its Property Law Section is not a pre-requisite, although it is quite likely that many of these individuals would have had some involvement with the PLS over the course of their distinguished careers.
