

# **Election under s317(1) LCA**

#### When to use this form

This form is to be used by a practice (sole practitioner/partner/incorporated law firm) to notify the New Zealand Law Society (Law Society), that it elects not to receive money or other valuable property in trust, pursuant to s317(1) of the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act 2006 ("Act").

#### Please note:

- Lawyers and incorporated law firms will be liable to contribute to the Lawyers' Fidelity Fund unless they make an election under section 317(1) of the Act and notify the Law Society that the election has been made.
- This election and certificate must be lodged with the Law Society.
- The practice will be required to make an annual certification pursuant to s112(2) of the Act and regulation 4 of the Lawyers and Conveyancers (Trust Account) Regulations 2008, no later than the 31 March in the year in which the certificate relates.

Please ensure you complete and submit both sections of this form. You may wish to retain a copy for your records.
